Literacy & English

- Begin to write sounds and words.

- Story telling looking at reciprocal reading strategies beginning with predicting.
- Think aloud where we listen to a text and answer questions surrounding what we have listened to.
- Play based experiences using sand, water, games, paint, craft resources, fine-motor tools and technology to consolidate learning.

Numeracy & Maths

- Looking at place value of numbers 0-10/20/50/100, focusing on recognition, sequencing and ordering.
- Looking at repeated patterns within number, shapes and objects.
- Looking at routines dates, days of the week, months of the year, seasons.
- Play based experiences using numeracy resources such as numicon, cuisenaire rods, rekenreks and dot patterns.
- Numbertalks to develop mental skills.

Interdisciplinary Learning

- Art and Design lots of drawing/painting experiences focusing on detail when using line and texture.
- French/Global Studies learning about French artists, greetings, numbers to 10/20 and classroom commands.
- Music Charanga music programme focusing on the beat and rhythm of music.
- Technology/science Designing using different materials/resources such as kapla/blocks/lego/junk modelling.

Our topic this term will based around health and wellbeing where we will be:

- Using resources such as the colour monster stories/inside out film to discuss feelings and emotions.
- Lots of fun experiences such as painting, crafting, designing and building.
