<u>Literacy & English</u>.

In Reading this term we will be continuing on in our use of PM reading books. We will focus on using higher order thinking skills and reciprocal reading skills such as predicting, summarising, questioning and clarifying. Our class novel this term is 'The Danger Gang' by Tom Fletcher. In writing we will focusing upon the core genre targets and building our writing stamina. As part of our listening and talking this term we will be reinforcing our four listening rules.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term, we have begun learning about Pop Art. We will continue exploring a range of popular artists from this genre. Art, Drama, Music and Health and Wellbeing through a range of exciting lessons.

We are extremely lucky to be working with Miss Martinez to learn both French and Spanish this year! We will be learning Spanish greetings and numbers to 20. Within French we will be learning greetings, classroom language and numbers to 50.

Numeracy & Maths

The development of mental maths skills, such as times tables, through quick recall of maths facts is a key focus for all pupils in order to provide a strong foundation for their new maths learning this term.

In Numeracy we are learning about place value. We will cover reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 99,999; partitioning whole numbers; identifying values of digits and rounding.

In Beyond Number we will be exploring Time. We will explore real life examples of these concepts.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u>

This term we will be reinforcing our knowledge surrounding the SHANARRI indicators and our School Values. We will also spend time learning about important table manners and using the skills we have developed during Snack, Chat and Learn. We have been developing a class charter and making links to the UNCRC Rights of the Child. Miss McAllister will take the class for PE on a Wednesday afternoon. The focus will be golf and fitness this term.

Mrs Jewell Smith joins us as our new school admin. She will be in the school office from 8.30am until 3.30pm each day.




Mrs Petrie joins us as acting Principal Teacher. She will be in school from Wednesday 23rd August
