Literacy & English.

This term in writing we will be focusing on Daily Writing to ensure pupils are following the Core Writing Targets. We will be engaging with "Think Alouds" to encourage pupils to contribute to a class discussion. There will be focusing on handwriting, to ensure all work as neat as possible. Pupils have also started planning for a whole class talk.

<u>Homework</u>

Please expect pupils to come home with reading homework from their class novel *most* weeks.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we will be being covering data science, music, drama and RMPS (Hinduism & Sikhism). The pupils will also be spending time with their P1/2 Buddies. Pupils have all been entered into the Duke of Edinburgh Awards at Platinum Level. Pupils will continue to explore French and Spanish with Ms Martinez.

Numeracy Vocabulary

<u>Place</u> - Where a number is located (for example Ones, Tens, Hundreds, etc...).

<u>Value</u> - How much a number is worth (for example in 123 the 2 is worth 20).

<u>Phrases for Addition</u> – plus, combine, more, sum, total, increase.

<u>Phrases for Subtraction</u> – difference, takeaway, minus, decrease, fewer than.

Numeracy & Maths

This term pupils will be having a close focus on their basic numeracy skills. This will include place value, rounding, addition, subtraction and times tables. Pupils will also be working on their confidence with time problems.

<u>Homework</u>

It would be great if pupils could find inventive ways to practice their times tables, as this will help them succeed in all areas of Maths.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u>

In Health and Wellbeing this term we will looking closely at the school values and SHANARRI indicators to ensure pupils have a clear understanding of each. We will also be investigating the UNCRC articles to ensure pupils have an understanding of their rights. We will also be looking at Developing the Young Workforce Skills, ensuring pupils are aware of the skills required to be successful in school and in their future career. P7's will be receiving barista training from WCHS and will open their coffee shop. Initially selling coffee to school staff, then when they grow in confidence, the wider community.

Mrs Jewell Smith joins us as our new school admin. She will be in the school office from 8.30am until 3.30pm each day.




Mrs Petrie joins us as acting Principal Teacher. She will be in school from Wednesday 23rd August
