

# Primary 6 Class Newsletter



Welcome to our class newsletter.

Have a read through all of the exciting things we have planned for the coming term!

## Literacy & English.

Our focus this term will be to continue with handwriting – presentation and spelling, building upon last term's work. We will be looking at Alliteration, Similes and Metaphors in our grammar sessions and within our reading sessions, we will be developing our comprehension and questioning skills linked to the reading we do in class. Our focus for writing this term will be to look at the structure of Information Reports. The children will have the opportunity to experience modelled writing and then produce their own pieces with increasing complexity.

Class talks will continue through this term with a child being chosen weekly and having 2 weeks to prepare. (Please see separate Success Criteria sheet sent home when they have chosen their topic to research).

# Interdisciplinary Learning

We will be focusing in-depth on Victorians, looking in depth at; schooling, working, Rich and Poor, British Empire, Advances in Science, Technology, Engineering as well as traditions of Christmas that were introduced during the Victorian Era.

We hope to work on our Enterprise and Eco skills for the Christmas Fayre, by making our own recycled paper for gift cards to accompany our key fobs made from recycled pencil sharpenings – sounds odd, but should be great!

### Numeracy & Maths

Within our Numeracy we will be continuing to working on our rapid recall of basic number bonds as well as our times tables. We will be looking at how we can use these skills in a variety of contexts to solve problems. We will focus on the 4 operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and the vocabulary associated with these.

Our Topical Maths will be focusing on Shape, Angles, Tessellation (tiling) and Symmetry.

Homework will include numeracy challenges and/or a topical maths task. You will find these on the Weekly Homework Diary sheet in your child's homework folder.

# Health & Wellbeing

Children will have 2 PE sessions per week - one with myself (Monday afternoon) and the other with Miss McAllister (Wednesday morning). This term will be Invasion games, both indoor and outdoor, so please ensure indoor and outdoor PE kits are brought on PE days.

Our Health and well-being in the classroom will be focusing on our GIRFEC - SHANARRI, which will be the focus during Snack, Chat & Learn. During HWB sessions will also be focusing on Person Hygiene, Substance Misuse - Alcohol & Tobacco and the influence that peer pressure can have on substance misuse.

We continue to use Plickers, as a daily check-in.

#### Numeracy & Maths Vocabulary

This is a variety of vocabulary, but is by no means exhaustible.

- 2D & 3D Shape names
- Tessellation (tiling)
- Angles right, acute, obtuse, reflex & straight
- Symmetry
- Rotation, degrees, protractors.
