## <u>Literacy & English</u>.

This term the writing focus will be an Information Report. Pupils will continue to follow the core writing targets to ensure accuracy. In Reading, we will continue to build understanding by answering higher order thinking questions. To promote Talking and Listening, pupils will be leading sessions with their P1 buddies.

Homework - Look out for reading and spelling homework activities.

#### **Interdisciplinary Learning**

This terms topic is a journey through the Medieval Period. We will be covering such themes as castles, battles, weapons, torture, life in different social classes.

This term we will be taking part in the Scottish Primary Engineer's Challenge. Pupils will be trying to come up with inventions that will solve problems. We will then design these products and enter them into the competition.

#### Numeracy Vocabulary

<u>Multiplication</u> - times, product, factor.

Division - share, split, equal groups, parts.

Hypothesis - a theory based on logic.

**Inverse** - opposite

#### Numeracy & Maths

This term in Numeracy we will be working on Multiplication and Division, whilst also recapping Addition and Subtraction. We will also continue to have "Thinking" lessons, where pupils work in small groups to solve problems together.

This term in Maths we will be covering Angles and Symmetry as well as Shape.

I would encourage all pupils to work on their times table recall and speed.

### Health & Wellbeing

This term in Health and Wellbeing pupils will be focusing on Personal Hygiene, Road Safety and Substance Misuse. Personal Hygiene will focus on pupils taking ownership of keeping themselves clean. Road Safety may include riding a bike and travelling safely on the public bus. If your child does not have access to a bike, we have some in school. I have handed out letters to pupils to receive their free bus pass, if this did not make it home please let me know and I will send another home.
